
DIY Garage Door | (R-3.0)

R-3 (Also Provides a Radiant Barrier Benefit in Warmer Climates) Reflectix[®] Installation Instructions



- 1. Reflectix[®] Insulation
- 2. Garage Door Frame
- 3. Garage Door Panel

Tools Required: Safety Glasses Tape Measure Utility Knife/Scissors

Fasteners:

Reflectix Foil Tape, acrylic adhesive tape, doublesided tape, spray adhesive, screws or staples

Recommended Products: Reflective/Bubble/Bubble/Reflective - Roll: BP24025 (24"x 25'), BP48025 (48"x 25')

Installation Instructions:

- Measure the door panels of the garage.
- Simply cut the Reflectix® Reflective/Bubble/Bubble/Reflective product to this dimension.
- Attach the product to the door panels utilizing an acrylic adhesive tape, double-sided tape, spray adhesive, screws or staples.

Review These Important Safety Guidelines Prior to Installation:

- <u>ALWAYS</u> check local building codes before installing Reflectix[®].
- ALWAYS check the area you are insulating and make any needed repairs. Any worn wiring should be replaced before you begin installing Reflectix[®].
- ALWAYS make sure work areas are well ventilated and well lighted.
- ALWAYS use eye protection when operating a staple gun.
- <u>ALWAYS</u> use caution and common sense when using a staple gun. Be aware of where electrical wiring is located. Stapling into a wire can cause severe shock or death. <u>NEVER</u> staple into electrical wiring.
- ALWAYS be careful when working with large pieces of Reflectix® on windy days.
- When installing Reflectix® on bright sunny days, it is best to wear sun glasses.
- Do not work in areas such as attics when temperatures are too hot.
